# Welcome to St Catherine's Church and Centre

## Adult Day Care Services

St Catherine's Church and Centre is a purpose built building situated one mile from the Centre of the City of Wakefield.

Our adult day care has 30 places per day, five days per week for older people. The aim of our service is to support people to remain independent and active members of their local community.

The Centre offers a wide range of activities tailored to suit individual needs.

### Our Mission

---

To ensure that our services provides fun, friendship and a personal touch.

We give our clients one to one attention and respect. We don't work with numbers, we work with people and their families.

### The Day Care service includes

---

Door to door transport to and from the service (if required).

A two course, nutritionally balanced lunch and refreshments throughout the day.

We also provide a huge range of activities for our clients which includes professional entertainers, craft activities, day trips, seasonal projects, reminiscing and much more.

We ensure that we personalise our service to take into account each individual client's requirements and individual life experiences.

## Who is eligible for this service?

---

If you think that you need Support Services then an assessment will be carried out by a member of our staff team or your local Social Work team.

- A referral can come from yourself, a relative, a carer, a friend or Health Professional.
- Access depends on the availability of places, but every effort will be made to accommodate your placement.

## When a place becomes available

---

The day at the day centre will be a trial giving you the opportunity to experience the service. At the end of the day we will have a meeting to 'review' your agreed care needs and your views of the service will be discussed.

If our service meets your needs and a place is available you will be offered a Service User's Agreement which sets out the terms and conditions of the service that you have been offered.

Staff will cover the document with you in full.

## Your rights

---

Staff will treat you with respect and actively promote your individual rights. You also have a responsibility to consider the rights and needs of others around you and you can expect the same consideration in return.

We believe that each person is an individual and that society should respect that individual and their fundamental rights as a citizen.

## Meals

Each day we offer you a nutritious meal with a varied daily menu.

There are hot/cold drinks available throughout the day.

If you require a special diet for medical, cultural or religious reasons, this can be arranged. Staff will be happy to discuss your diet with you at any time.

If you require assistance at meal times, staff will arrange this for you.

How much do I pay?

---

Some of our clients are eligible for funding via Wakefield Council and your charge will be based on the amount of services you receive and your ability to pay for these services. Your Social Work team will be able to explain this to you. You can also access our Day Care Service as a private client at an all-inclusive fee starting from £33.00 per day.
